The program is Kurt Weill and Bertolt Brecht's *The Seven Deadly Sins*, a highly satirical one-act opera written in 1933. This concert production, directed by Adrienne Boris, will be approximately 45 minutes long. The complete program will also include assorted sinful songs and arias. The show is 21+ and there is a \$10 cover charge. Doors open at 7 and the show starts at 7:30 pm. Advance tickets are NOT available.

Opera Boston Underground will be hosted by Opera Boston Music Director Gil Rose, and feature young Company singers Glorivy Arroyo, Christian Figueroa, Stefan Reed, Rob Woodin and Graham Wright, and pianist and Musical Director Eve Budnick.
